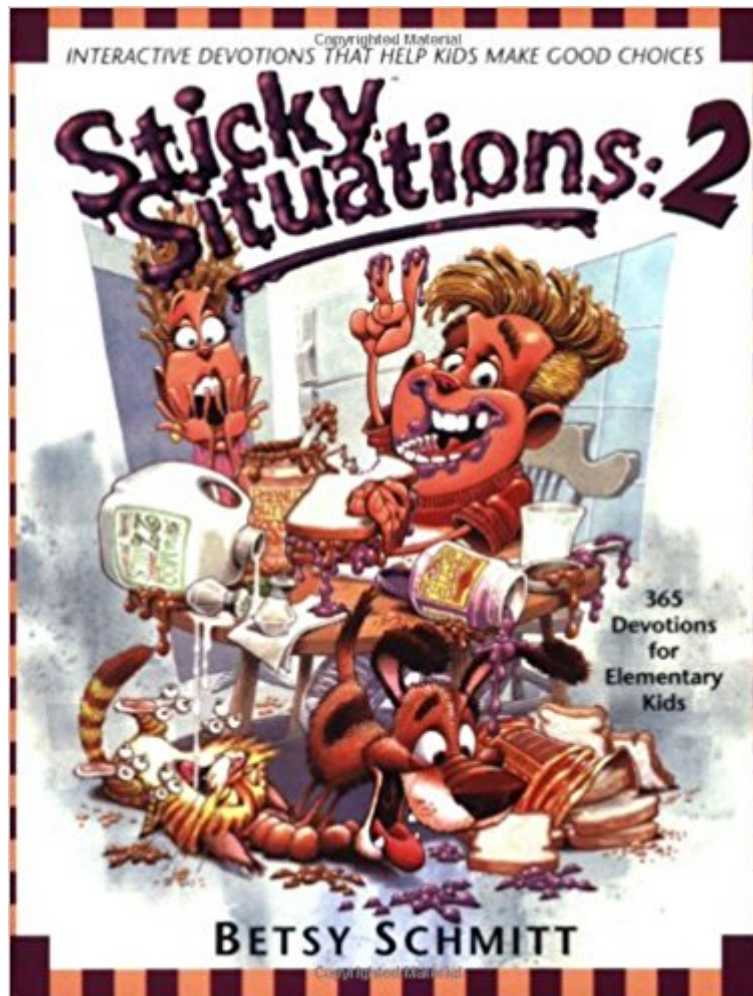




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Sticky Situations 2: 365 Devotions For Elementary Kids

Our Pastor for children's services at church told me about this book. This is such a fun and great book for children. We, as a family have read them together after dinner. It's great to see our daughter decide which is the right way to react in certain situations. There are so many scenarios here that certainly our children will come up against some of these in their life. It's great to know they will be better prepared to handle them after doing these exercises. Doing them as a family helps to connect us all and reinforces that we are "family-strong" and are here to support one another!

Both my children look forward to these lessons before bedtime. The lessons have definitely built their confidence and character. This book bridges real life "sticky situations" elementary kids may

find themselves in to Bible verses explaining how God would want them to behave in such situations. The children are given a real life situation and then asked to choose from three options on how they think the child should resolve his or her "sticky situation". A Bible verse is supplied to help the children see how God would want them to handle it. I found that my children often know the correct answer, though they may not have chosen to act that way in the past. This gives them the confidence to know that though choosing the right behavior may not be the easiest, it is ok to take the hard path as they will have the support from God to do so. Each month works on a different virtue. This book has been a life changer.

This is a great devotional for my 7 y/o daughter. She has a hard time paying attention to other devotionals, but not this one! This one is just right for her! With any other devotional we try to read she starts getting squirmy, but this one is fun. In the beginning, it will tell you what you will cover for the month. It has a verse for the theme of the month. Each devotional has a short scenario with a quiz at the end. Followed up by the verse covering why you should have answered in that way. The book has activities thrown in the month for them also like dot-to-dot, and at the end of the month they go over what they learned with a review. It's fun to end the night doing this devotional with my daughter.

I have been reading this nightly with my girls ages 7 and 9 for the past few months. It is quick and to the point and maintains their short attention span. My only problem is that many of the Scriptural passages are used out of context. It seemed the author wanted a Bible passage to fit their story and just grabbed one that appeared to work. Still, I have enjoyed the time using this book with my girls. Almost every night, I hear them yell from their room, "Dad, it's time for Sticky Situations".

I really like this devotional for my 6 1/2 year old daughter. The devotionals are short, but always include a short scripture reference and encourage her to apply the scripture to her decision making. Situations are relatable and age appropriate. My daughter can read this on her own, however she prefers that we read it with her at bedtime. She's a strong reader, but I believe that most first graders and up could read it with little trouble. She would have been fine reading it in kindergarten. A solid devotional. If you're looking for something pretty straightforward that includes a scripture challenge, this is a great choice.

this book offers great discussion topics that are fairly realistic. Each day's devotional has a section

that asks what the person in the story should do. Then multiple choice answers. It's pretty engaging, but at times the correct answer is really obvious. I think the book could've offered answers that are a bit more challenging. Regardless, our kids love the last section which is normally where the parents are giving some life experience that is relevant. All in all a good family devotional that is applicable to both of my children, a 9 year old boy and a 6 year old girl.

I home school my son who is a survivor of a traumatic brain injury. Part of his brain damage involves behavior issues and lack of impulse control. This book has been an excellent way to back up the lessons we have been teaching him (over and over and over) for years. He is *shocked* and thrilled every single day when the answer to the problem is found in the scriptures! There have been times in his life when he has told people he did not "believe in the bible," but this book has helped him achieve a greater understanding of the truths held within the Word. He may not always apply the lessons, but I find comfort in knowing the lessons we teach him are backed up by scripture consistently and often in many different places. This book is easy to use, easy to read, short and sweet yet thought and conversation provoking. I strongly recommend it for ALL parents wishing to reinforce the way the bible is fully applicable to today's sticky situations.
