

Just like navigating the waterway itself, there are a variety of ways to explore the many books and stories about this national treasure. A first must read is the richly detailed but highly technical Waterway Guide: Atlantic ICW 2015. After the rough seas of that excursion, sail into calmer waters with Allan Fisher and James Amos's visual and poetic 1973 narrative, America's Inland Waterway. After the practical Guide and the dreamy National Geographic Society paean, Gene and Katie Hamilton offer a breezy travelogue of their 1,243-mile journey. The three works give you vastly different perspectives on the same body of water. The Hamilton's requires the least

amount of 'tacking' and 'jibing' and makes for a quick read. Their personal touch is found in the movie and recipe suggestions they pair with each portion of their route - "Being in Virginia Makes Us Hungry for..." or "Our Favorite South Carolina Flick." This is a conversation in book form - it reads as if you are on deck cruising with them as they make their way south. It's an accessible style that is light on sailing terms and focuses more on the sightseeing aspects of this legendary waterway. Except for the heavy use of "really" and "very" and "nice", I really liked this very nice book.

Nice book for folks starting to learn about the ICW and what it has to offer. Not real long and may get someone interested to travel on the ICW.

The book is far too short, just a bunch of really brief descriptions with an anecdote here and there. Fairly decent writing, but I was expecting A LOT MORE about the ICW. It's more the equivalent of what should be a free PDF sampler of a much longer book.

Great book.....well written...packed with usefully information that all boaters should know before they take the cruise by power or sail for the first time, or if they are seasoned boaters going on their tenth trip.

The book is written so it is easy to understand. There is a lot more to see than is discussed in the book though.
