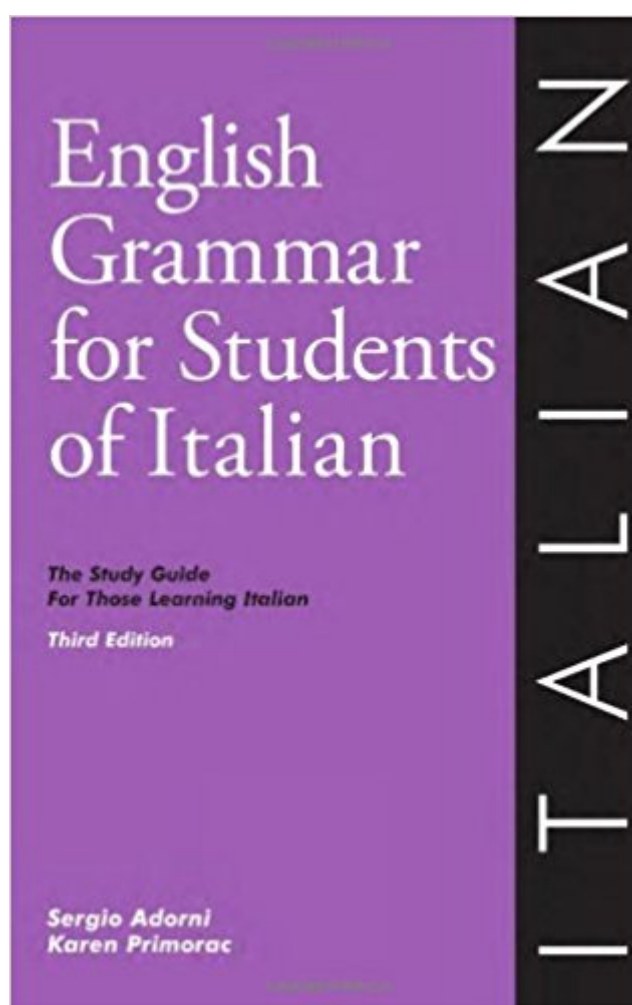


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English Grammar For Students Of Italian: The Study Guide For Those Learning Italian, Third Edition (O&H Study Guides)
