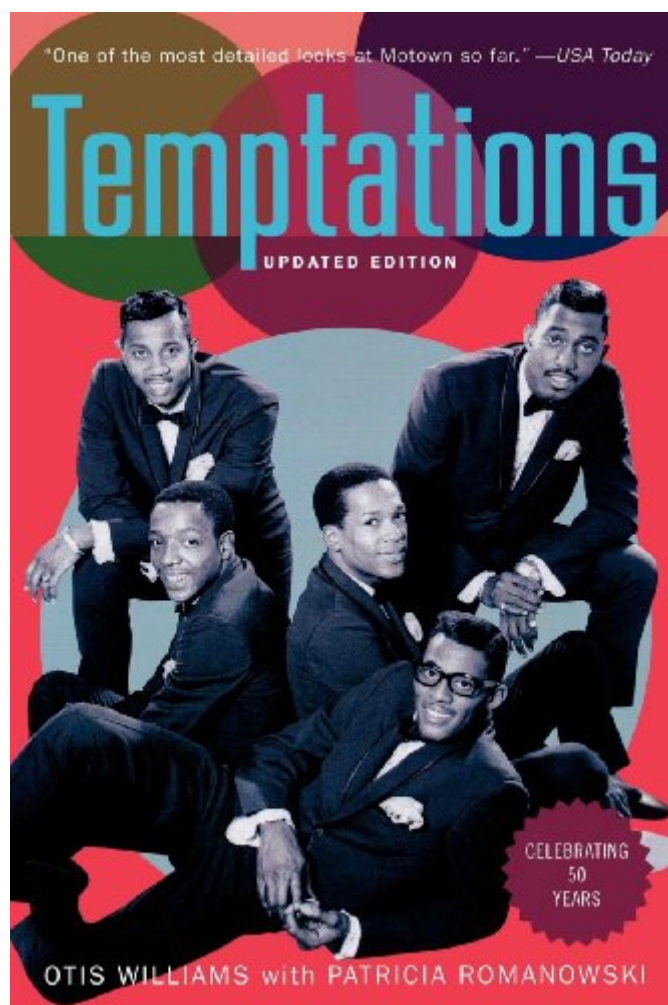


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# Temptations

I really loved Otis' point of view of the Temps. I found it to be a page turner and once I got it I could not put it down until I was finished. Keep in mind though that this book is OTIS' VIEW of the temps before you start judging it. It starts off with Otis telling his beginning years of singing, but ultimately it IS about the temps. I would remind you that this book was published in 1988, only Paul Williams was deceased by this time.
