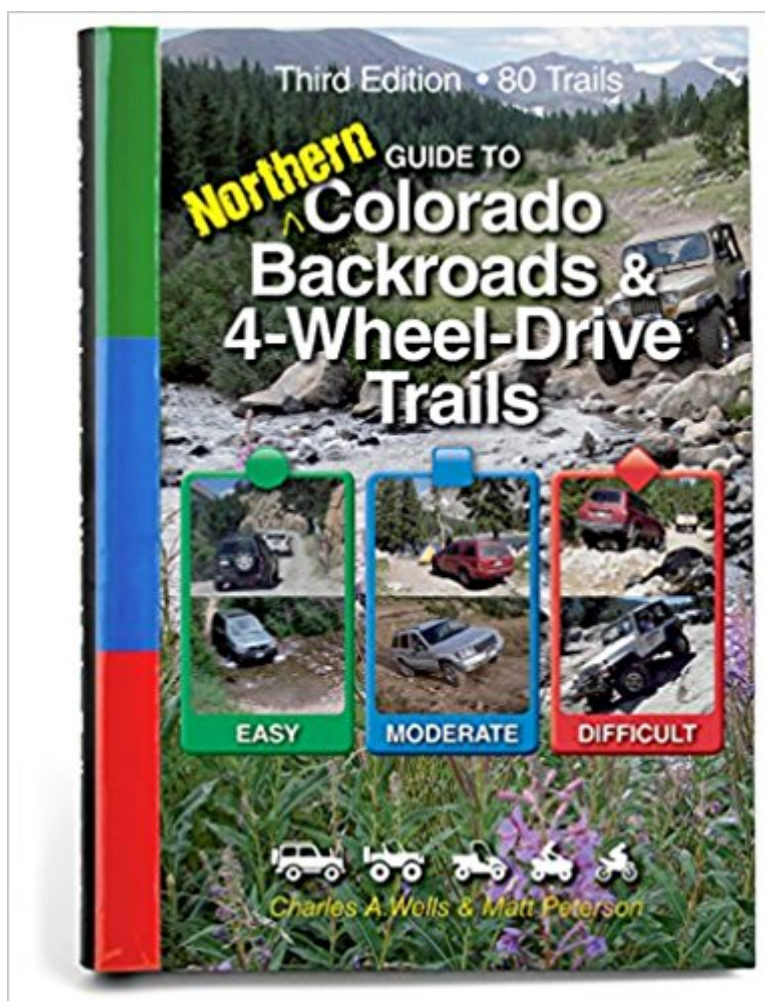

This includes unlicensed UTVs, ATVs and dirt bikes. A separate mileage log ties numbered locations along the route to a custom map and Aerial Terrain view. GPS coordinates are provided for each numbered location and may also be downloaded free from the FunTreks Web site. Included are reverse mileages for all trails and historical highlights. Every book includes concealed spiral binding that lays flat for easy use. Heavy-duty plastic laminate cover withstands rough use. (Not available in square back format.) If you are a first time visitor to the area looking for jeep trails you need this book. Next to talking to the locals this book will let you know where to go and gives great directions to the start and along the trails. Only reason I did not give the book 5 stars was from my experience on some of the trails

in this book. I found the trail descriptions leaning towards the cautious side maybe a little to much. But on the other hand better this way than to get people in trouble. I'm just being picky here but I will say this series of trail guides belong in your jeep or FWB if you are planning a trip to the covered areas. I guess I've talked myself in to a five star rating for all three of Mr. Wells and Peterson's books.

I'm a total off-road rookie and recently purchased a 2014 Jeep Wrangler Unlimited Sahara. THIS IS A MUST HAVE FOR BOTH ROOKIES AND EXPERTS! It shows many trails and rates them easy/moderate/difficult. I've been slowly working my way through each level of trails. Great maps, excellent descriptions of how to get to each location and detailed trail mileage. Great book for anybody in Boulder/Longmont/Loveland/Ft Collins area.

I've had this book for a long time and just refreshed it to get the spiral bound version. I was new to off-roading 6+ years ago when I went out to visit a friend in Colorado for the first time after purchasing a truck with 4x4 and skid plates. The book has been immensely helpful for a novice like me, who is willing to take his stock truck on some moderate adventures. I skip the advanced/difficult stuff, so no idea how well those are documented. For what I need, it's perfect. Easy to read and very well documented.

I have lived in Colorado my whole life and this book is still really helpful. The trail descriptions are really accurate and the vehicle recommendations are dead on. They use gps coordinates for the start points and other spots on each trail. If you have a Garmin you can plug them in and drive right to the trail. Very informative descriptions of trails and what to expect.

This book was recommended many times to me while I was out exploring trails. I finally broke down and bought it. It is a great book describing some trails around Colorado. Lots of good info! My only complaint is I wish there was a newer edition.

These are the only books to buy for trail advice and locations... only issue is with only 3 categories, (easy, intermediate, difficult) it's hard to judge without talking to others who have run the trail, what is REALLY difficult, and what is just difficult for a stock rig. I have a 99 Tacoma with 33' tires and a locker and many of the difficult trails I walk through... yet some need lockers front/rear and 35+ tires.

I ordered this book to locate jeeping trails in other areas of Colorado. For years we have jeeped the beautiful trails around Silverton and Ouray, Colorado. We decided this year to go somewhere new. I ordered this book and also it's companion book, Guide to Colorado Backroads & 4-Wheel-Drive Trails 3rd Edition. I thoroughly enjoyed reviewing both of them to plan our July vacation. The descriptions of the trails in both books seem to be very informative. I can't wait to use them as we explore new territory. I received both books in a timely manner and in excellent condition.

Moved to Colorado from the east coast and needed a guide to the trails and this book has been nothing short of excellent. Have driven about 6 of the trails thus far and directions to trailheads, GPS coordinates and miscellaneous information has all been useful and spot-on. The thoroughness of the information has meant there have been no surprises and I have not found myself in a bad spot. Consider myself an intermediate level driver and believe this book would be easy to comprehend and use for a novice.
