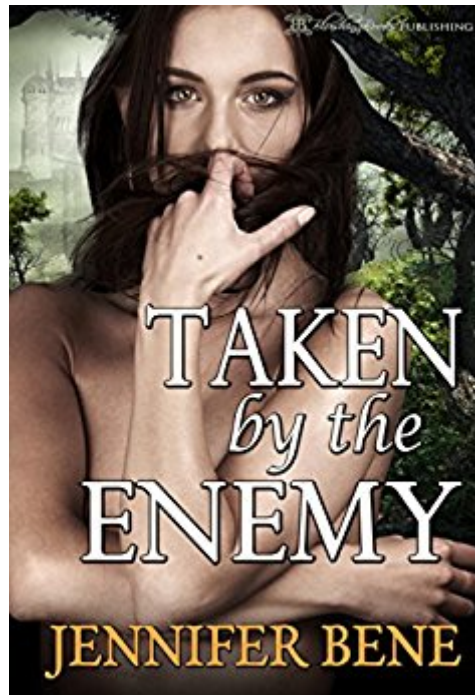

Emmie leaves her sheltered life by escaping into the woods that surround her walled city to avoid a arranged marriage. She quickly finds herself in trouble in the woods only to found by a group of people that have been exiled from the city. People she has been taught her life to fear. Lucian quickly reinforces those fears when his group saves her from a Boar attack and takes her to their remote village. Emmie's pride and stubborn ways soon have her butting heads with nearly everyone, especially Lucian who has decided to make her his own using whatever means he has to in order to get her under control. The book is very well written and although contains explicit sex scenes and violence was a enjoyable read. So much so that I had to read it one day as I was so hooked on what was going to happen next. There are many well developed characters that add to the story. A highly recommended dark erotic book.

I read this a while ago and for some reason neglected to post this review. Oops. This was one of the first stories I read by Jennifer Bene and I have a few more stacked up on my Kindle waiting for me. Overall, I liked it. The almost medieval dystopian world where the rich and influential still oppress the rest was depicted well. The differences between those living in the communities versus the other side of the wall were like night and day and personally, I think I'd choose the woods. Likes: This actually was a dark erotica story. So many of these get labeled that way when in fact, they aren't. Lucian was the right mix of alpha and reluctant hero. The sex scenes and corporal punishments while harsh, weren't over the top for this story. Dislikes: While I liked the idea of Emmie and at times, really did enjoy her character, there were too many instances where I found her downright annoying and bratty. Yes, I realize that's the point of her character but I generally can't stand brats and I feel like she took too long for her transformation. Of note, that's my opinion based on my own personal preferences and really, the fact that she did grate on me is testament to the

author's writing. As other reviewers have noted: This has dark elements, so if they aren't something you enjoy, don't waste your time. But if those are of interest to you, then pick up a copy of this story.

The author built a good dystopian world, but it was reminiscent of Kit Rocha's series, so it felt somewhat unoriginal. The hero had some questionable ethics, and the heroine was stubborn because she could be, not because it made any sense, so I wanted to smack her. Having said that, I think that Lucian's persistence was well done, and Emmie's turn around toward the end made me feel satisfied with the HEA.

Okay I gave the book a 5 and gave the review a scary name!!! What is going through my head?!? I am a constant read and rarely do I ever have a problem with putting a book down and walking away. With this book I just couldn't walk away. I wanted to know what was going to happen next and if things were going to end up okay. I became extremely invested in the characters within minutes of starting to read. Either way no spoilers, and no dislike from a book that can have me reading through the night when I have to be to work at 7am

I was drawn into this dark erotic story with a corrupt government system, evil men controlling people, a system that exiled people from the city without a fair trial, leaving them to die. People inside the city were told those that were exiled were no more than wild animals. Emmie is being forced into a marriage to a sadistic man and flees the city to the forest, but dangers lurk with wild animals. Saved from a wild boar and captured by exiled warriors is like jumping from the frying pan into the fire. The plot kept me captivated and the pages turning with the resourcefulness of those in the village that had been rescued after being exiled. There are rules and order in the camp, and everyone is expected to pull their weight. Emmie is in for a rude awakening as she is belligerent, mouthy and has to learn a new way of life. From the village to the city, this story will take the reader on a roller coaster ride that is intense and raw, including rape, dubious consent, coarse language, spankings, anal play, but it offers a dark story that also has loyalty, determinations, survival and love stories too.

Great novel, with some really hot scenes, and a gripping story line. I highly recommend this one. This is my first novel by Jennifer Bene, and it certainly won't be my last!

I have to admit there were some parts that really angered me but the love story between Emmie and

Lucian had me hooked. Overall great book.
