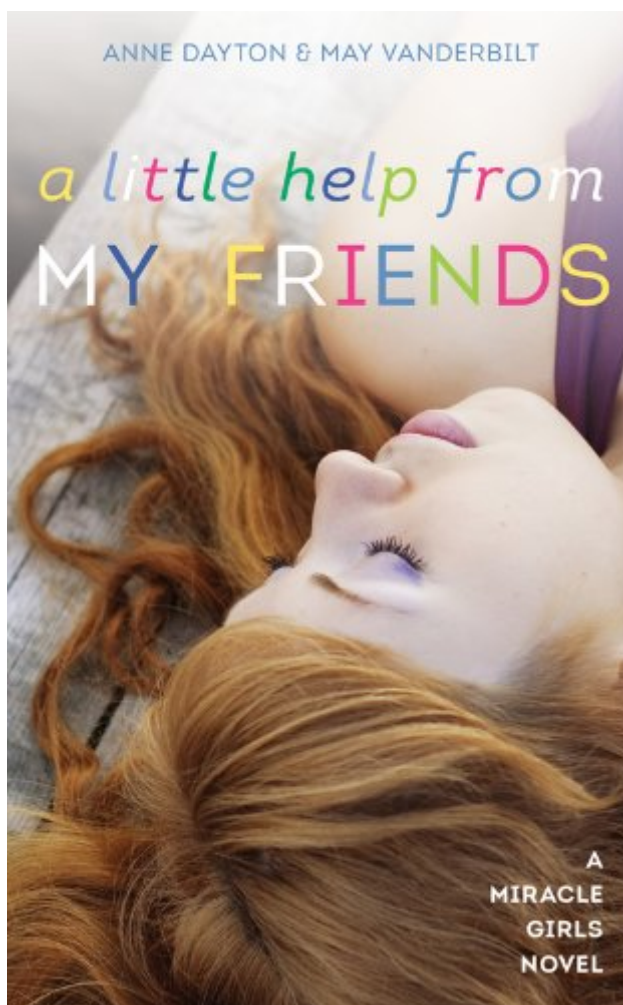

I know a little about how Anne Dayton and May Vanderbilt write together (from reading their combined blog back in the day), and I think that's my favorite part about their stories - it's amazing how seamless the storytelling is throughout. The authors also paint their scenes so well, I feel every minute. I love the texture of this book, from the evolving friendship between the Miracle Girls to Zoe's memorable home and family. Zoe is a junior, and her story is very authentic to that age - much more young adult than child. The romance in the book is perfectly written for young readers but pretty grown-up as far as the emotion is concerned and the decisions Zoe has to make. Teens will love every minute of the Miracle Girls series, but I read and loved them as an adult. Absolutely perfect for fans of great friend stories (e.g., *Just as Long as We're Together* by Judy Blume), teens with a Christian worldview, and anyone who loves YA best (as one should). The only reader-beware goes out to the current generation of Joshua Harris girls, if you still exist. There's no no-dating message here, a caveat I would not even mention if I had not specifically recommended the book for the faith set, within which I was a Harris graduate myself, making me overly aware of the difference between the no-dating life-ology and this more traditional approach to teen romance. A note on the series aspect: You don't need to read the first two in the series to get this book, but reading all four gives you the fullest picture of these four girls and their friendship. They each have a unique story to tell.

I started it three times but just couldn't get into it. Its young teen agers and their relationships with each other. It brought in reincarnation and other stuff I don't care about plus I am past my mid eighties so I just couldn't relate. It would be interesting to young teen agers but just not for this old codger. Good luck!
