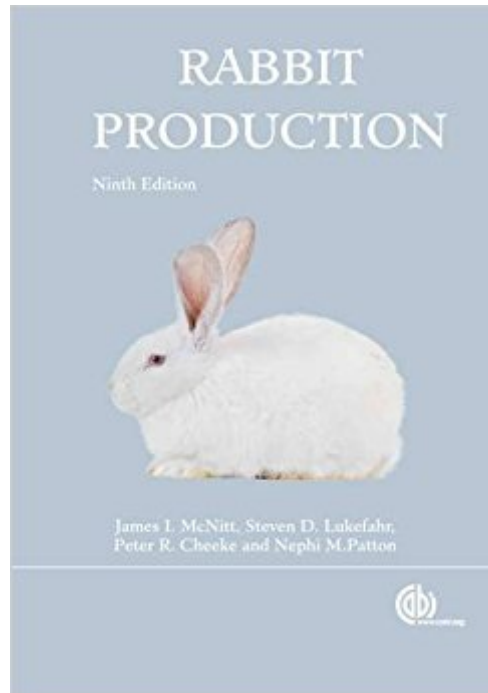

In comparing yes there is more information that has been updated and that is all wonderful but I found the Breeds of Rabbits Pictures greatly disappointing they are some of the worst I have seen and do not represent there breeds well at all. The people could have asked ARBA (American Rabbit Breeders Association) for updated pictures of the different breeds. I putting this out there cause I think the book is great but ask that those

getting into Rabbits to PLEASE check with reputable breeders before buying there stocked based on the pictures in this book for example the New Zealand in the book if just awful and looks nothing like today New Zealand. I think what they did with those pictures was use one they have used since the 1968 5th Ed book from what I compared they were the same rabbit. On another note would have loved to see more of the other pictures in the book be in Color with the price being so high.
