


The book was found

She succeeds them with her Blood of Kings trilogy. Follow the whirlwind journey of Achan, a young man whose status is lower than a slave, who not only discovers that he is the long lost heir to the throne, but also the one anointed by the One True God. Not a believer at first, Achan soon walks in fellowship with Arman. Gifted with the legacy of bloodvoicing, Achan is the strongest one of all. He is befriended by Sir Gavin. Before long, Achan is thrust into a terrifying war to claim his birthright and destiny. Knights, Giants, a boy who is really a girl, Duchesses, Dukes, and demons are only a few of the companions and foes. Temptations, daring rescues, torture and cruelty, and thieves bombard Achan and his knights. This is a story about false idols, love, the One True God, and honor. Superbly written in a fast pace, it will honestly keep you up for hours until you turn the last page. Especially with the twists and turns thrown your way. Williamson's books break the thin line between young adult and adult fantasy. Entertaining and thought provoking...

From Darkness Won is the third and final volume of The Blood of Kings trilogy by author Jill Williamson. Achan Cham, who was earlier revealed to be the real Prince Gidon Hadar has now assembled his army and is preparing to invade Armonguard, the capital city of the country of Er'rets, and take his rightful crown away from the usurping forces of the demonically-controlled Lord Nathak

and Prince Esek. But his task is more difficult than things would seem to be at first glance, for the very demonic presence that controls his rivals, which calls itself the Hadad, is far more powerful than Achan could ever hope to be. Only with the help of Arman, the One True God, can he hope to defeat this enemy. At the same time as all of this is happening, Vrell Sparrow, the assumed name of Lady Avarella Amal, is in trouble. Shortly after being captured by Esek's allies, she was stormed and her soul has fled her body. She has forgotten everything and may not be the same even if she is reunited with her body. Achan is determined to save both his country and the woman he loves. The question is whether he can succeed. This was a terrific read with a much tighter plot than the earlier two books. There was very little in the way of "filler" (real or perceived) in this work. Every passage, word, and so on, had an exact purpose and thus there really weren't any boring parts. That said, this was not a perfect work. There were a few things I had a problem with. First of all, the way that the Hadad was defeated was nonsensical to me. Not that Arman defeated the creature. That made perfect sense and was really the only way this could happen given the build-up to this event throughout the trilogy so far. No, what made little sense to me was how everyone just on the word of Achan immediately changed from idolatrous to obedient disciple of Arman at the drop of a hat. It would have been better had it been stated that Arman supernaturally used Achan to move hearts, with Arman causing the people to change when they otherwise would not have done so. That sort of thing. Instead, it comes across as Achan being ridiculously persuasive. The second issue I had was with the kind of moral repugnance the characters are steeped in. included in this would be the God of this universe, Arman. Apparently, the king and queen, Achan's parents had the king's son with his mistress banished and gave the order to have him poisoned and drugged every day to hide his powers. Upon discovering that Achan had been drugged/poisoned for years, Sir Gavin blew a gasket, but upon hearing what his old pal King Axel and his wife Queen Dara did, he was fine. No evil there at all, no sirree bob. And worse yet, it's hard to not perceive that Arman approves of this, unless you think He allowed the king and queen to be murdered as punishment. Of course, that would arguably be equally disturbing, but who knows? I find it quite sickening how the characters are fine with this. And for those who wanna yak about how this is a medieval story convention (and true to real-world history at times) I don't care. I can still criticize the portrayal of a child abuser and abandoner, and his enabling wife, as not someone characters or especially the fictional analogue of God Almighty should be okay with. The final issue I had was one I had with the trilogy as a whole. That is that the good characters who serve Arman lecture those who don't believe, but that's it. With the exception of Sir Gavin to Achan or Achan to Gren, you hardly ever see them actually preaching His Word to folks and trying to lovingly persuade them of the Truth of Arman. It becomes harder and

hard to sympathize with folks who seem to spend their time self-righteously badgering, when more earnest, concerned preaching would have come across better. Those were my major problems with the plot. As I said, though, this book was overall a great read and was much more enjoyable than the previous two. I especially enjoyed the story arcs of Achan and Vrell, and enjoyed watching them move closer together. The whole sequence with the memory loss was a bit contrived, in my opinion. It almost seemed the author did this to explain Vrell's change of heart. But it worked, nonetheless. It was sweet and a great part of the story. All in all, it was a wonderful read.

This last book of the blood of kings trilogy completed a thrilling series! It was great fun to watch the characters develop over the sequence of books. It was fascinating to see the lands and the inhabitants evolve over time; some in positive ways and others in negative directions. There is a lot of hardship along the way but through it all, God's plan is there for those who seek him and believe in him.. interesting journey.
