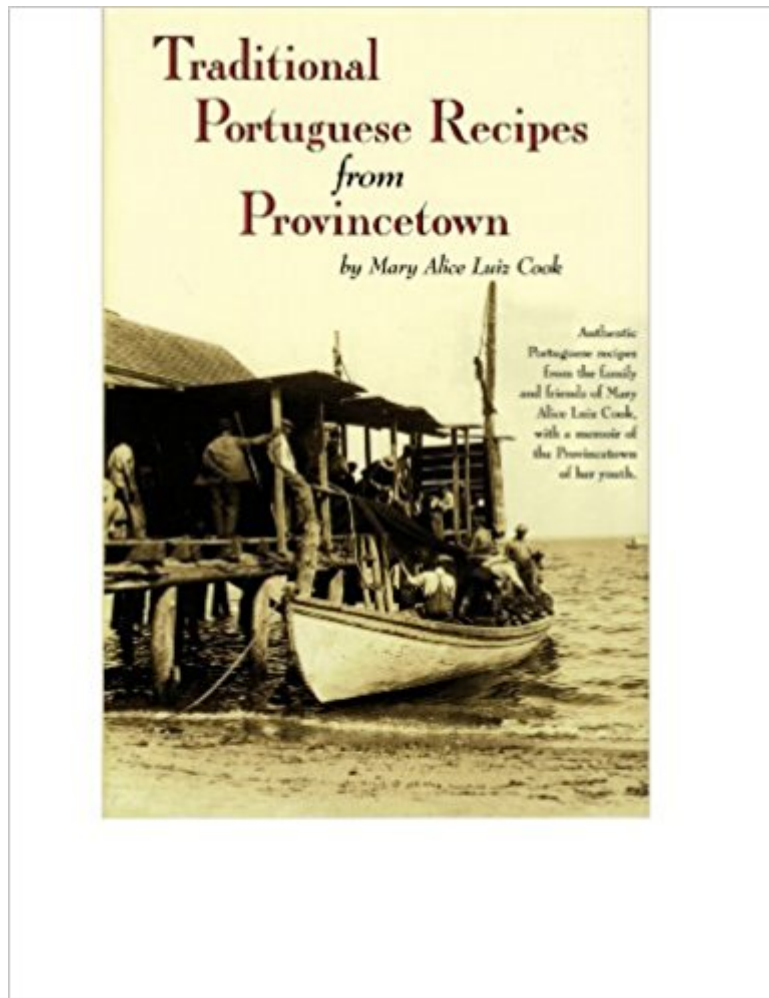

Mary Alice Luiz Cook was born in Olhao, Portugal, in 1914, the daughter of a fisherman. She came to Provincetown in 1915 and grew up eating and speaking Portuguese. She learned to speak English at Provincetown High School and graduated in 1931. Her husband, Edward Cook, a Petty Officer in the Coast Guard, was stationed in Provincetown on the C.G. Cutter Harriet Land when they met; they were married in 1938. Until she died in 1993, Alice Cook lived in the family home on Alden Street, the house her father bought in 1925 and where her three children were born. Alice was well known in the local community for her culinary skills and her warm heart. She started writing

this recipe book and her memoirs of Provincetown in 1976 because her many friends were always requesting family recipes and asking her to tell stories about Provincetown in the "old days." We are fortunate that she left this record of her Portuguese heritage as her legacy to the town and to all those who knew her.

Mary Alice Cook was my mother's dearest friend. Although my mother was not Portuguese, these two lovely women would work together in the kitchen of our home.
