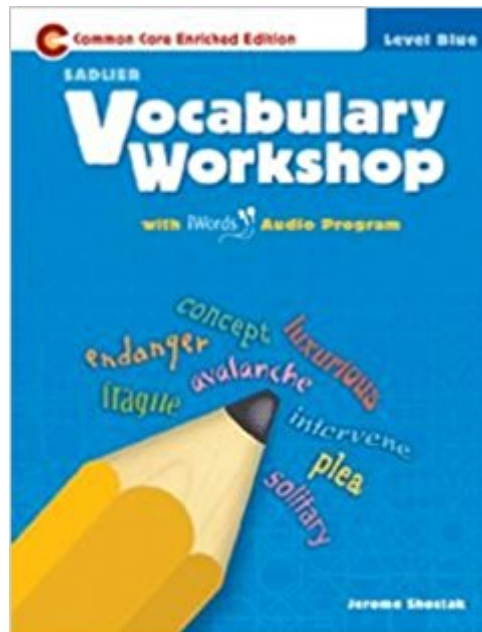

The lack of real words that they are not teaching in GA with this common core crap is horrible. Thank you for providing this product so that I can give him the same education I had. Parents will want to review with children because some of the content is not simple although all the answers can be found in the materials.

Basically it's OK. My son's teacher uses the Wordly Wise books in class, and I was looking for something similar to give him extra vocabulary practice. Wordly Wise is just so much better. One of the lessons in the vocabulary workshop books just has him fill in the the missing word in a sentence, but actually tells him the vocabulary word to use along with it's definition. He likely won't read the definition, but will just copy the word down. Both have a passage to read which uses the vocab words, but wordly wise always uses non-fiction passages which not only use the vocab words, but are interesting and educational and then has comprehension questions after. These questions

either contain a vocab word or require him to answer the question using a vocab word. Vocabulary workshop's passages are more simplistic and don't have comprehension questions following. I just feel the exercises wordly wise uses to reinforce the learning of the words in each lesson are much better.

As a homeschooling mama, I love these books. My kids have learned so much from all of the different activities they are assigned to help them put their vocab words into practice each week!
