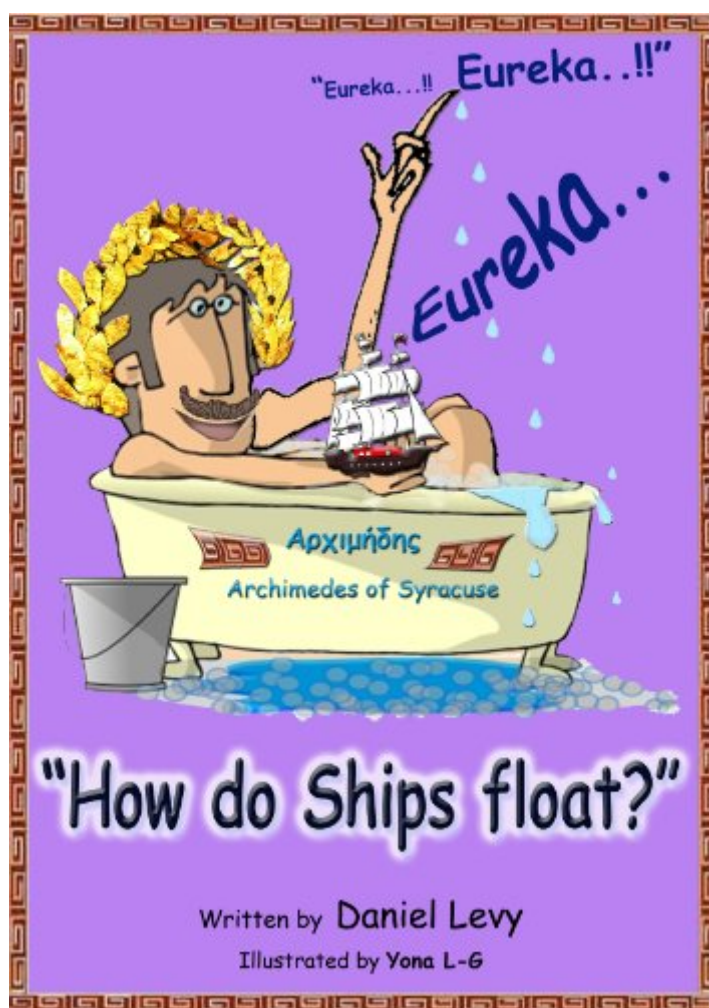

He ran naked along the streets of his city, Syracuse, and shouted all the way home "Eureka! Eureka!", a word in ancient Greek which means, "I have found it! I have found it!" The word, eureka, is still used today by someone making a surprising discovery. Entries mentioned in this book, to my grandchildren, about the entries, as follow: - Archimedes of Syracuse; The Claw; The Catapult; Robotriks; Regularly shaped body; Finding the volume of an object with an Irregular Shape; Buoyancy Principle of Floating Bodies; Swim Bladder Aircraft carrier.
