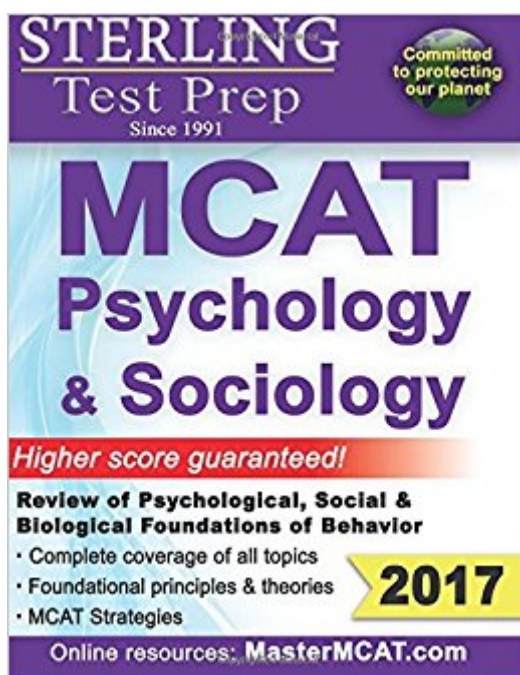

I need a good psychology and sociology review book because I didn't take psychology with thoughts of needing it for the MCAT. This book refreshed many of the principles and taught me many others. Book is easy to understand and the table of contents (I checked in great detail) has the same topics for psychology and sociology as listed by AAMC for the new MCAT. The book goes into detail but is well organized and clearly written. A nice balance between needed concepts and being understandable. The concepts I needed for the MCAT without extraneous content.

I am a post-bac at the Harvard Extension School. I graduated a few years ago as a biochemistry major and have been working in research for 2 years. I consider myself a strong student with a great foundation in the sciences needed for the MCAT. A few classmates of mine took the MCAT last year and recommended the Sterling Prep books. I used several of their products (along with some donated book from other publishers). The Sterling products are very comprehensive and covered the psychology and sociology component with great detail that was needed on test day. ⚠️ Buyer beware: high degree of overlap in various sections. It's as if different authors were hired to write separate sections of the same chapter, but they were never in communication with each other. While all information is clearly explained and accurate, there is poor content editing throughout the text. Those looking for evidence of my complaint can turn to pages 470, 485, and

487, where the concept of "social mobility" is defined three different times in the same chapter. These are not offhand references to the same concept: each time the text describes "social mobility", it dedicates several paragraphs to the task, as if it is the first time the reader will encounter it. This book provides you with excellent review 75% of the time, and wasteful overlap 25% of the time. If that's what you're looking for, fire away!

It had some relevant information but it had TONS of extraneous information that could be cut from the book. For instance it basically copies exactly what the DSM V says about psychological abnormalities including a lot of detailed diagnostic information that is way outside the scope of the MCAT. There were several times while reading this book that I felt like I was wasting time because it went into too much detail about something that doesn't seem important or should just be common sense.
